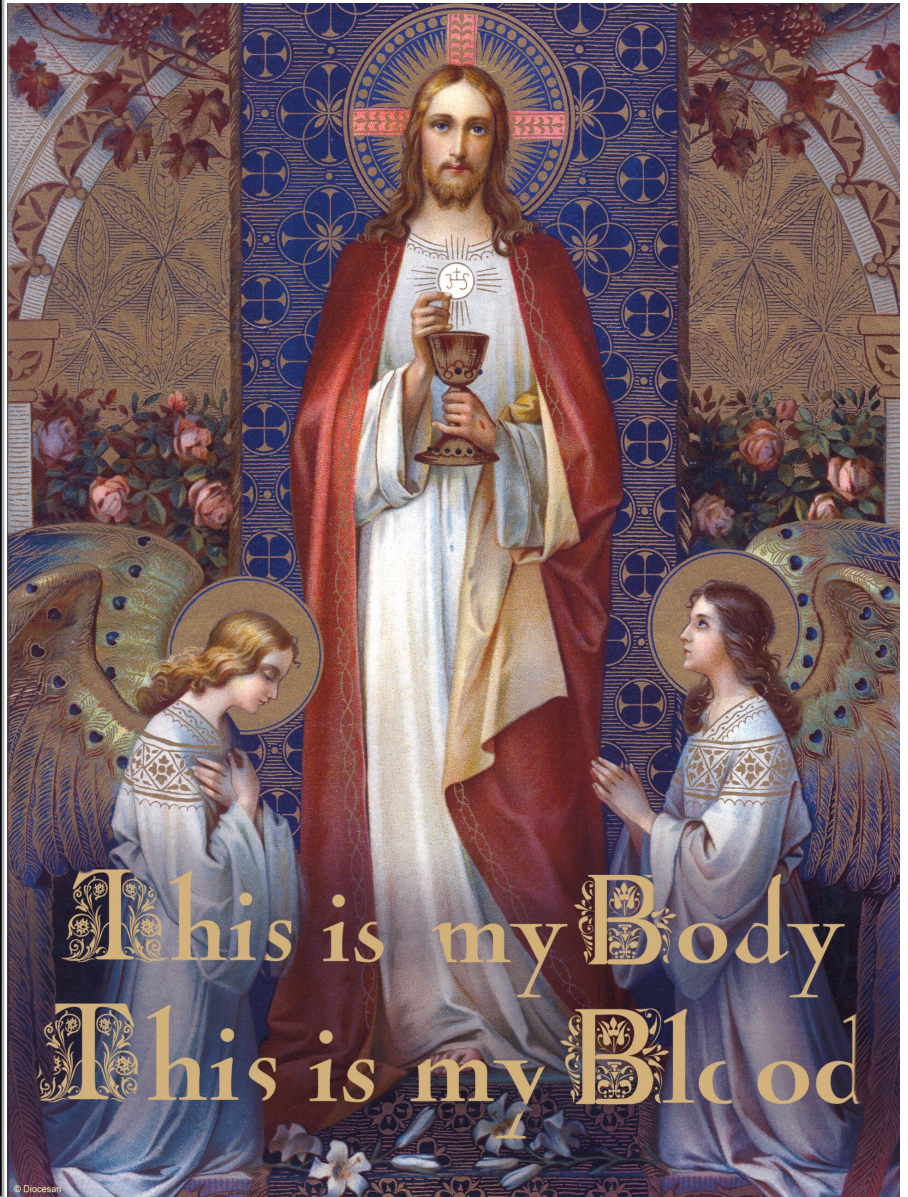

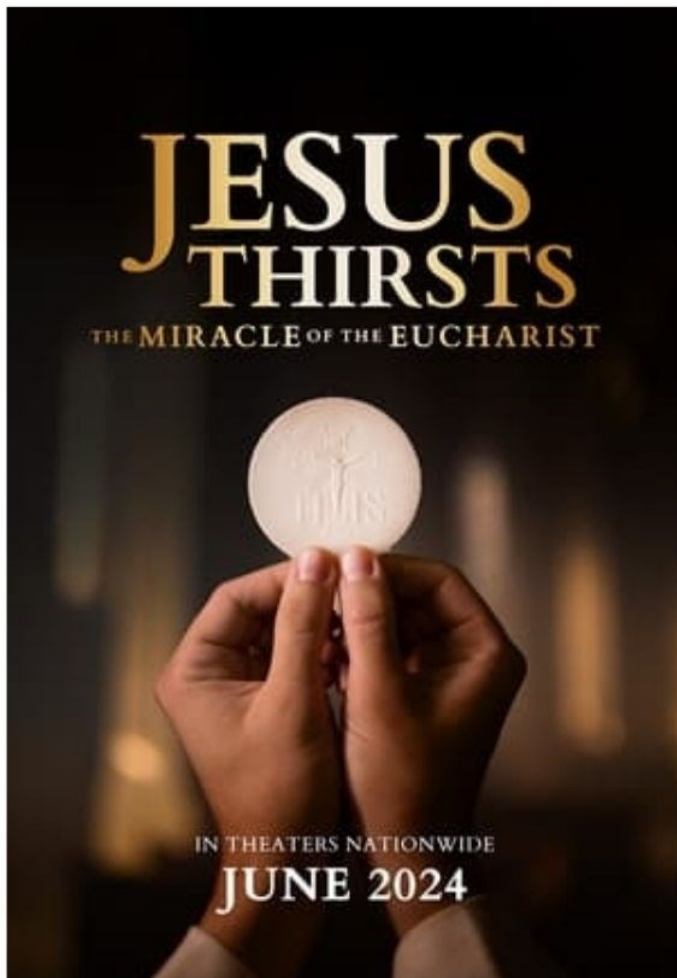

## CORPUS CHRISTI SUNDAY

### CORPUS CHRISI

Celebrating the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, we rejoice because we are loved so much by Almighty God that He gives us His Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity to give us strength and to deepen our union with Him! This feast began in the Diocese of Liège in the 13<sup>th</sup> century and spread through the Catholic world to become a universal feast in 1371 by a papal bull of Pope John XXII. On Holy Thursday we focus on the institution of the priesthood, the institution of the Eucharist, the washing of the disciples' feet, and the agony in the Garden of Gethsemane. A feast focused solely on the Holy Eucharist was needed. What a gift we have been given! What love we have received! Jesus Christ truly present in the form of bread and wine!

Tomorrow, June 3<sup>rd</sup>, is Fr. King's First Anniversary of Priestly Ordination! What a blessing his priestly presence and ministry have been to St. James and to the whole Church!
