As we enter the depths of summer, may the Lord grant you abundant rest and relaxation on your vacations! May they bring about renewal and rejuvenation!

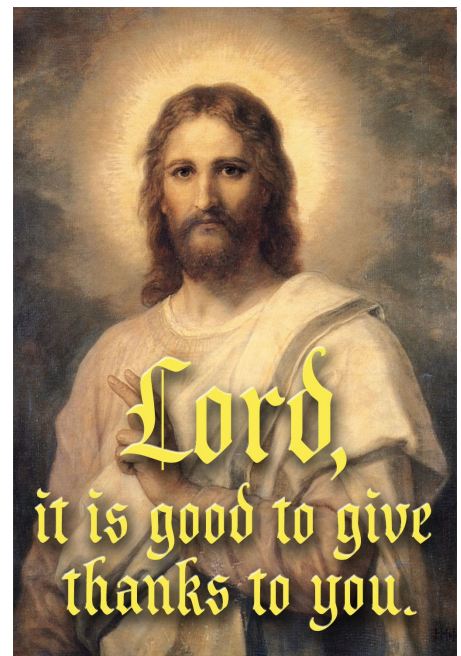
Don't forget to tend to your spiritual life as we tend to our need to slow down a bit and rest! There is no break to our relationship with Jesus!

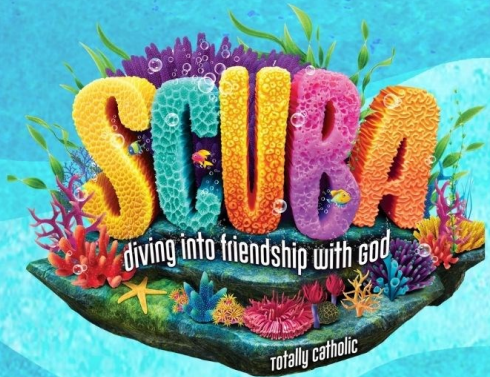

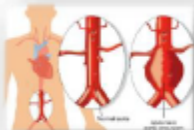

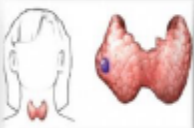
