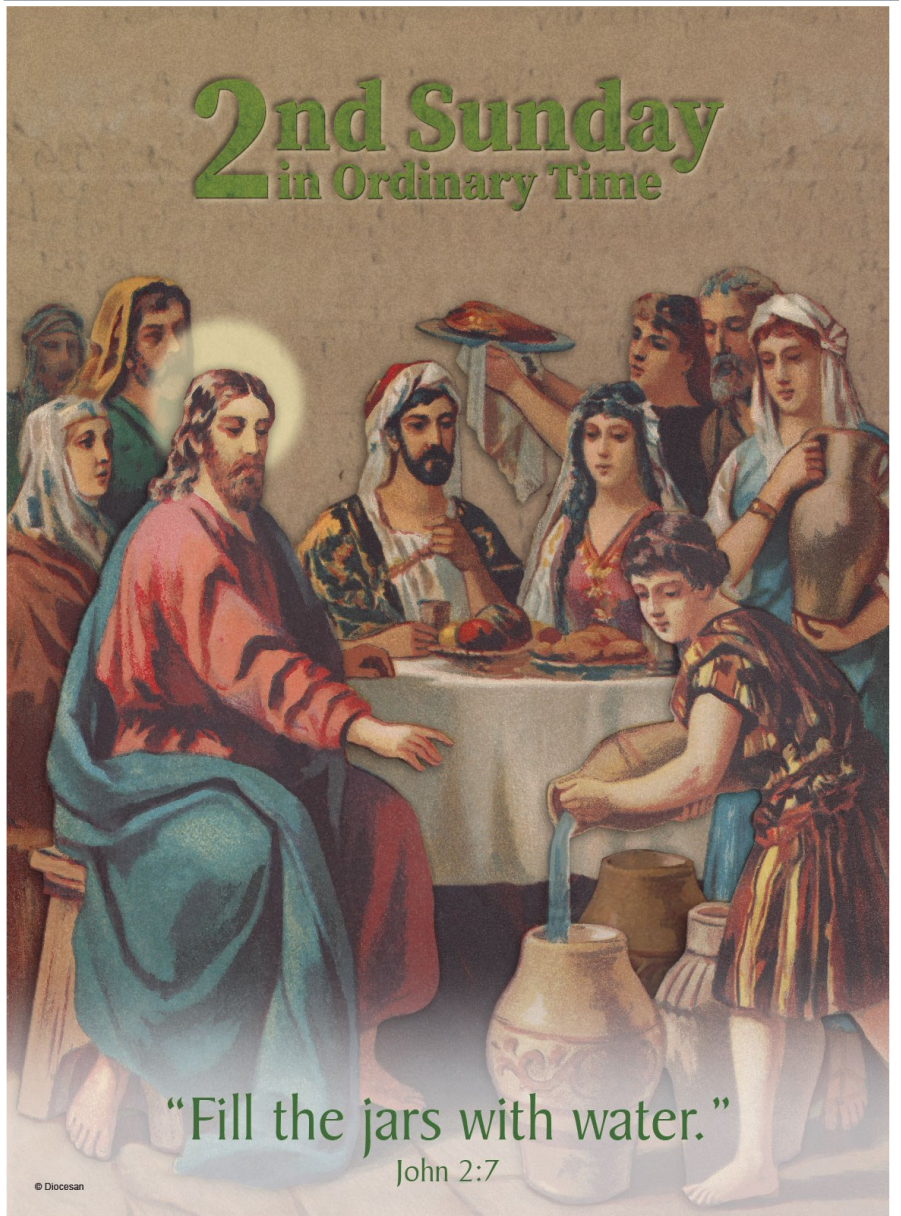

PASTOR'S CORNER

2ND SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME

1ST RECONCILIATION

In the Gospel of John 20:22-23 we read, "He breathed on them and said to them, 'Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them; whose sins you retain are retained.'" With that, Our Lord Jesus gave to the Apostles and their successors and the priests ordained by them the power to forgive sins. The priest in the confessional continues the healing ministry of Jesus. He came to heal us from the wounds of our sins and reconcile us to God the Father and to one another. This work continues in Sacrament of Confession/Reconciliation.

Thursday evening this week, approximately 50 of our young people will experience for the first time the beauty, healing, and mercy of God in this sacrament! If you have ears to hear, there will be an abundance of joy in heaven that evening! "There is more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine who think they have no need of repentance." 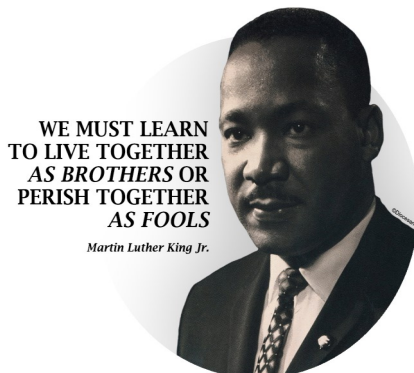

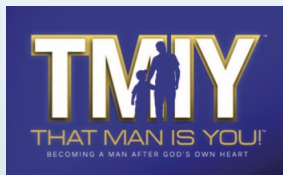
